What is LAMP? It is a cross-cultural ministry sharing Jesus Christ with God's people in remote communities in northern Canada. Rev. Les Stahlke recognized that many Christians in the North were isolated and spiritually unsupported and many more did not know of Jesus. He began visiting these communities in his small, single-engine aircraft, and with the support of the LWML, churches, and others, the ministry grew.

How does LAMP serve? Sent by churches in Canada and the United States, volunteer missionaries hold Vacation Bible School and serve alongside locals in meaningful ways to reach children, youth, and adults. Social media, off-season visits, texts, email, and mail have helped volunteers to encourage and build year-round relationships with the Indigenous people they have come to know as family!
